Duties and responsibilities will be as follows:

- 3. Monitors and maintains fleet reliability by developing corrective action programs for chronic or repetitive problems.
- 4. Maintain and monitor action logs initiated by the ensure corrective actions are implemented.
- 5. Analyze performance data to identify corrective items through trend and root cause analysis.
- 6.Review all operational data collected in CASS to assure proper ATA coding of information.
- 7. Attends CASS meetings, records minutes, action items and generates reports.
- 8. Generates company discrepancy documents as directed by the Manager of CASS.
