Description:

The Quality Inspector's primary responsibility is to ensure aircraft, aircraft parts, major assemblies and installations task are performed according to the approved data and complying with regulatory requirements in a timely and efficient manner.

Essential Functions & Responsibilities:

- Performs preliminary, in progress, hidden damage and final inspections. Performs special inspections as detailed by the requesting or requiring document. Performs Required Inspection Item (RII) and Buy Back inspections.
- Ensures that inspections and surveillance are performed as required on necessary maintenance actions in order to assure the use of approved data, material, tools and test equipment and that high standard of workmanship are present.
- Conducts daily audits of aircraft work packages including checks/inspections forms, log pages, routines and non-routines, modification orders, etc. to ensure completion, correctness, use of appropriate references to approved data in all entries and forms.
- Ensure that processes as; Calibrated Tools, Shelf Life Items, quarantine and beyond economical repair (BER) parts are accomplished in accordance with company policies.
- Support other activities as required by company requirements and management direction
- Ability to work any shift and weekends as required.

Qualifications:

- FAA Airframe & Powerplant certificate, required.
- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- 3 years on large commercial aircraft related experience (minimum).
- Must have good English communication (written and verbal) skills.
- Experience in computer applications such as Microsoft Suite, Word, Excel and PowerPoint preferred.
