



Position Summary:

As a flight Attendant at World Atlantic Airlines you are required to perform and assist with the performance of Inflight safety (Regulatory), customer service, cabin preparation duties and communication/cooperation with the flight deck crew.

General Requirements and Qualifications:

- At least 21 years of age.
- Must be in possession of a valid United States passport.
- Fluent in the English language, both written and spoken.
- High school diploma or general education degree (GED)
- Minimum 3 years of customer service experience
- Must be able to work out of any of our crew bases for a prolonged period.
- Satisfactory 10-year background history, including criminal background.
- Able to pass a pre-employment Drug and Alcohol test and as well as a Covid-19 test.

Essential functions:

- Ensure safety standards on board are met and passengers comply with applicable Federal Aviation Regulations **(FARs)**.
- Provide outstanding customer service and assist passengers while on board.
- Complete necessary paperwork and reports as outlined in the Flight Attendant Manual.
- You must always be prepared to handle any type of emergency at any time during a flight.
- Comply with company policies as outlined in the Flight Attendant Manual and Employee Handbook

Physical Requirements:

- Ability to push/pull/lift objects weighing up to 70 lbs. and be able to push, pull, or move a beverage cart
- Standing or walking for extended periods



- Possess the physical strength to reach and operate all emergency equipment and exits
- Demonstrated ability to work in aircraft aisles and galleys, standing, walking, kneeling, bending, twisting, working in a cramped or awkward position, and squatting.
- Fit into the jump seat and harness without any modifications.
- Ability to comply with company uniform and grooming standards while on duty.
- Tattoos must not be visible at any time (Examples of visible tattoos include, but are not limited to: Hands, arms, neck, face, legs, and feet)
- Ability to walk and fit comfortably down the aircraft aisle while facing forward and able to fit quickly through the over wing exit.
- Ability to hear and respond to customer and crew communications in situations with high background noise.
- Having no problems with outdoor exposure to weather.

Schedule:

World Atlantic Airlines is an on-demand charter airline – therefore requiring flight attendants to be available for flights while meeting regulatory rest requirements. Weekend travel, holiday travel and weekly travel is to be anticipated.
